Terms of Reference (ToR) Human Security Training Workshop

Project Goal:

The overall goal of this two-year Strong Cities Network (SCN) programme is to ensure strengthened P/CVE activities coordination and delivery in selected municipalities in Lebanon and Jordan. The WANA Institute will build the capacity of municipalities and local PVE networks (LPNs) in Jordan. A similar programme is also being delivered in Lebanon concurrently. Methodology and Scope of Work:

The Consultant/ Trainer is required to deliver a six-days training/workshop in at the Dead Sea. These workshops will contain informative sessions to familiarize 28 LPN members with the following:

Day one:

- Introduction to “Human Security”
- Concepts of Radicalisation, and Violent Extremism: Between prevention and countering
- The Jordanian context in preventing and countering violent extremism

Day two:

Moreover, the Trainer will conduct a training on Management and Strategic Planning of Prevention Initiatives.

Deliverables:

In close cooperation with the WANA Institute the Trainer is expected to:

1. Create the methodology and training/workshop curriculum. The training is to be interactive and engaging, content that stimulates discussion.
2. Conduct a total of 6 days training/workshop – 2 days for each LPN.
3. Prepare training material in Arabic.
4. Prepare two days agenda in Arabic.
5. Provide WANA with two proposals per network of prevention initiatives.
6. Produce presentation covering the relevant topics.
7. Conduct the pre-post evaluation of the training/workshop.
8. Report on the conducted trainings/workshops.

Duration and time frame

The trainings/workshops shall be conducted between January 23, 2021 – January 28, 2021 as the following:

- 23 and 24, January, 2021 (for Zarqa's LPN)
- 25 and 26, January, 2021 (for Irbid's LPN)
- 27 and 28, January 2021 (for Karak's LPN)

A brainstorming session with the WANA Human Security team is desirable prior to finalising the training programme and methodology.

Competencies, and Experience:

- High academic degree in a relevant discipline such as international relations, political science, conflict and peace studies, strategic and security studies, or related field.
- Extensive experience in conducting trainings for organisations in the area of human security, P/ CVE and conflict resolution.
- Excellent communication skills.
